Meeting Notes September 2017

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program: As Luther High will be participating in the Choice program beginning with the 2018-19 school year, parents of students in grades 5-8 will be invited to attend an informative presentation at 4:00 PM on Sunday, October 22. Mr. Terry Brown of the Choice program will provide information and answer questions.

Children's Theater: Board approved additional performance of the children's theater presentation on Monday, October 16th. This would be an afternoon performance offered to students in grades 1-3 enrolled at the three Onalaska Public Schools (Northern Hills, Pertzsch, and Eagle Bluff)

Dual Credit Courses – The number of students enrolled in dual credit courses has increased significantly from the previous school year. This is encouraging because it allows us to enhance and extend our curriculum with little to no impact on our school schedule or teaching loads. Courses in partnership with Bethany Lutheran College include Government, Statistics, Psychology, College Writing, Intro to Fiction, Music Appreciation and US History. 20 students (6 boys, 14 girls) are enrolled in 44 classes. Last year we had 4 students enrolled in 3 classes.

Students taking a course required for graduation have been and need to be reminded that failing to pass that class jeopardizes graduation.
